MOTION FOR APPOINTMENT OF
A SPECIALIST TO EVALUATE
DEFENDANT'S SLEEP DISORDER
(EX-PARTE)

COMES NOW the defendant, through his undersigned attorney,
and respectfully shows the court the following:

1. Charles E. Guyer, a licensed psychologist, was appointed
by the court to evaluate the defendant.

2. Pursuant to the court's order, Dr. Guyer administered
psychological tests upon the defendant at the jail on October 28,
November 5 and November 18, 1997. On December 2, 1997 Dr. Guyer
concluded his investigation by interviewing the defendant's
parents.

3. Pursuant to a request dated October 17, 1997 the
undersigned did receive copies of the defendant's medical records
from the Department of Veteran's Affairs on December 8, 1997.
The medical records indicate that the defendant did receive
extensive treatment while in the military for sleep disorder.

4. In his report, Dr. Guyer recommended "a thorough
evaluation by a certified sleep disorders clinic which utilizes a
multidisciplinary approach." Dr. Guyer went on to advise the
undersigned and the court that Moses Cone Memorial Hospital in
Greensboro has such a program under the direction of Dr. Clinton
D. Young. The undersigned is advised and believes that Dr.
Clinton D. Young would be willing to conduct an evaluation of the
defendant if he is appointed by the court.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned respectfully prays that the court
authorize payment of Dr. Clinton D. Young's fees and expenses up
to the amount of \$3,000 and that the court authorize Dr. Clinton

D. Young to proceed with the evaluation of the defendant and that he be admitted to the Guilford County Jail in order to conduct his tests directly to the defendant.
